

Boston/Cambridge

Boston is the capital and largest city of the state of Massachusetts. It was the scene of several key events of the American Revolution, such as the Boston Tea Party and the Battle of Bunker Hill. Cambridge, with a population of 105,000, is a city situated directly north of Boston, across the Charles River. It was named in honour of the University of Cambridge, England and is home to two of the world's most prominent universities, Harvard University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

On Monday, 2 December **New Zealand Youth Choir** join the **Boston City Singers** and its Artistic Director, Kiwi Jane Money, for a concert in First Church, Cambridge. Established in 1633, First Church is one of the oldest congregations in New England.
